The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 17.1.2019 passed by this Court in Crl. Misc. No. M-1920 of 2019. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 2 to objectively consider the representation dated 12.10.2018 (Annexure P-11) and to take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, in case found necessary, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.”

Short reply dated 9.9.2019 by way of affidavit of Manoj Yadava, Director General of Police, Haryana filed in Court is taken on record. Copy thereof handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Along with the reply, order dated 3.6.2019 has been annexed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the reply filed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, he seeks liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law against the order dated 3.6.2019.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
