Mr. Varun Mittal, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of the complainant and filed *vakalatnama* which is taken on record and has opposed the grant of bail on the ground that the prosecution has concealed true facts and are hand in glove with the petitioner.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sher Singh, Police Station City Barnala, submits that petitioner in consequence of order dated 20.05.2019 has joined the investigation and nothing is to be recovered from her and does not oppose the

grant of bail.

In light of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 20.05.2019 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
