Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0122 dated 16.10.2018 under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Kapurthala.

Vide order dated 14.11.2018, interim bail was granted to the petitioner subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of the arresting/investigating officer and joining investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that during the pendency of the present petition, the matter has been compromised between the parties and a settlement agreement dated 15.02.2019 has been reduced into writing. As a result thereof, a quashing petition i.e. CRM-M-

10436-2019 has been filed by the petitioner and his mother. In terms of the settlement agreement, the petitioner has already paid a sum of Rs.3 lakhs to respondent no.2-complainant by way of demand draft dated 20.02.2019 at the first motion stage. He further states that the remaining amount of Rs.3 lakhs is required to be paid at the second motion stage, which is fixed for 02.09.2019. He has produced a photocopy of the settlement agreement dated 15.02.2019, as entered between the parties as well as a photocopy of the bank draft dated 20.02.2019 for an amount of Rs.3 lakhs in favour of respondent no.2-complainant.

In view of the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 14.11.2018 is hereby made absolute.
