1. Through the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for issuance of direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect lives and liberty of the petitioner from respondents No. 4 to 11 by providing adequate security/police protection to the petitioner and also directing respondents No. 4 to 11 not to interfere in the personal lives and liberty of the petitioner or to harass him in any manner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the purpose of instant petition would be achieved, if, respondent No. 2- Superintendent of Police, Nuh, is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate action.

3. In view of the above, respondent No. 2- Superintendent of Police, Nuh, is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate action, if required within two months from the date of receipt of the order.

4. The instant petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
