Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.31 dated 02.02.2018, registered at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar, under Sections 307, 326, 325, 341, 324, 323, 427 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act, 1959.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner is named in the FIR. As per the allegations, the present petitioner pulled out the complainant from his car and co-accused, Pardeep Kumar alias Ballu, picked up the licensed revolver lying in his (complainant) car and fired a shot upon him (complainant) but he managed to escape. As per the FIR, the

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complainant. There is also allegation that the petitioner alongwith co-accused also damaged the Skoda car of the complainant.

Keeping in view the serious allegations against the present petitioner and in view of the facts that *datar* is still to be recovered and further that he has played active role in the commission of offence, I find that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
