Petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.303, dated 20.05.2018, registered under Sections 406/420/506 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sadar Dadri, District Charki Dadri.

Affidavit of Superintendent of Police, Charkhi Dadri has been filed in Court today, which is taken on record. Copy supplied.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already joined the investigation.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State, on Instructions from ASI Puran Kumar, has submitted that no doubt the petitioner has joined the investigation, however, recovery of the amount is still to be made.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the co-accused of the petitioner has already returned the entire amount, half through cheque and half in cash. He further submits that the dispute is a money dispute. He further submits that the complainant is son-in-law of

Assistant Sub Inspector working in Haryana Police and therefore, petitioner has been falsely implicated.

Mr. Vikramjit Singh, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, on instructions from ASI Puran Kumar, has submitted that the investigation is complete and challan is ready to be presented in Court.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the co-accused of the petitioner has already been granted anticipatory bail vide order dated 12.09.2018 passed in CRM-M-27355-2018, the interim protection granted to the petitioner vide order dated 15.11.2018 is also made absolute.

Accordingly the petition is allowed.
