ANIL KSHETARPAL, J.

Petitioner prays for regular bail in FIR No.276 dated 04.10.2017 registered under Sections 307, 326, 452, 506, 148 and 149 IPC (Sections 302 and 201 IPC added later on) at Police Station Daba, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the petitioner was not named in the FIR and subsequently after a period of one year on the statement of complainant, the petitioner is sought to be falsely implicated. She has further submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 04.08.2018. She has further submitted that the investigation is complete and challan has been presented. She has also submitted that charges have been framed and the case is now fixed for prosecution evidence.

It has been brought to the notice of Court that there are 30 witnesses to be examined by the prosecution, out of which only one witness has been partly examined till date.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is sought to be implicated in the case on the

statement of complainant, which was suffered after a period of one year, therefore, it is considered appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.

Petition stands disposed of.
