The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 5.12.2018 passed by this Court in CRM-M-13546 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to file the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. In FIR No. 120 dated 17.8.2017, under Sections 308/452/323/324/148/149 IPC, registered at Police Station Guruharsahai District Ferozepur.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurcharan Singh, submits that the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been prepared and the same will be presented before the trial Court within a period of two months from today.

In view of the same, this petition is rendered

infructuous, at this stage. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a fresh, if so required.”

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that the directions were to do the needful within two months.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Jaspal Singh, submits that challan would be presented today during the course of the day. She further submits that the delay occurred as investigation was going on.

In view of the explanation and considering the fact that challan would be presented today during the course of the day, no further order is called for in the present contempt petition. Accordingly, the same is dismissed.
