FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This order shall dispose off first anticipatory bail application filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. by petitioner Deepak Joshi in case bearing FIR No.0089 dated 21.09.2018 registered at Police Station Women, Sector 16-A, Faridabad under Sections 376/506 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 15.11.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kallu Singh, Police Station Sector 16, Faridabad who submits that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

Though on behalf of the complainant Mr. Ravi Malik has sought to oppose the grant of bail on the ground that the petitioner is guilty of cheating the prosecutrix by backing out of his promise to get married, however in the light of stand of the State, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 15.11.2018 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, he will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
