In CRM-M No.14651 of 2016, prayer for regular bail was declined on 23.05.2017 to the petitioner(s) in a bunch matter which was comprising of CRM-M No.39093 of 2016, CRM-M No.32192 of 2016 and CRM-M No.35686 of 2016.

Thereafter, some of the cases were allowed to be dismissed as withdrawn keeping in view the complicity of the accused.

On 14.01.2019, this Court after appreciating the earlier orders passed on 21.11.2018 and 17.12.2018, adjourned the case in order to apprise this Court about the latest status of the trial.

At the relevant time, only 12 prosecution witnesses were left to be examined and out of those 12 witnesses, six witnesses were summoned for 15.01.2019.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Inspector Hardevpreet Singh states that all the prosecution witnesses have been examined on 11.02.2019. Accused have been examined under Section 313 Cr.P.C. and now the trial is fixed for 28.03.2019 for defence evidence.

In view of aforesaid position, no indulgence can be granted to the petitioner(s) for grant of regular bail.
