By this petition, filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail'.

The petitioner having been in custody for the past almost one year, with 9 defence witnesses still to be examined, and he being the former father-in-law of the deceased, though the deceased was still stated to be residing at his home, and the husband still being in custody, I deem it appropriate to admit the petitioner to bail during the pendency of the trial, subject to him surrendering his passport to the trial court.

Consequently, this petition is allowed. The petitioner would be enlarged on bail, upon his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the

satisfaction of the trial Court, and upon surrendering his passport to that court.
