TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J. (ORAL)

As per pleadings on record, petitioner No.1 got married to respondent No.5 on 05.06.2015. Currently petitioner No.1 is staying with respondent No.2.

Instant petition has been filed seeking a mandamus for directing the official respondents to take necessary steps for protection of the life and liberty of the petitioners by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of respondent No.5.

Having heard counsel for the petitioners and having perused the pleadings on record, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioners to approach respondent No.4 i.e. the Station House Officer, Police Station Anaj Mandi, Patiala as regards the threat to their life and liberty is concerned and as has been voiced in the instant petition.

In the eventuality of the petitioners approaching respondent No.4, he would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted in accordance with law.

It is, however, clarified that this Court in no ways is approving the liaison between the petitioners No.1 and 2 and the instant order has been passed confined to the aspect of the threat to the lives of the petitioners.
