GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking of direction to the official respondents so submit a status report with regard to his complaint dated 11.4.2018 (Anneuxre P-3).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he had purchased a flat from M/s Star Homes and that respondent No.4- Gurmeet Singh is one of the partners of the M/s Star Home and that now the private respondents No.4 to 6 have been threatening and harassing petitioner to pay additional amount of ₹1,74,000/- and had in fact dis-connected water supply to the flat where the petitioner is residing and had also used derogatory words. It has been submitted that although the petitioner has submitted a

complaint to the Police, but no action has been taken thereupon.

3. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case and veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali, to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-3) expeditiously in accordance with law.
4. A copy of this order along with copy of the representation (Annexure P-3) be sent to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
