By this order, CRM-M-768-2016 and CRM-M-44004-2015 shall stand disposed of, which have been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Through the present petitions, quashing of FIR No.70 dated 24.07.2006 under Sections 420/463/467/471/120-B/506 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Jhansa, District Kurukshetra, challan report dated 20.08.2006, order dated 17.05.2012 of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kurukshetra summoning the petitioners as an accused while allowing application u/s 319 Cr.P.C., order dated 28.09.2015 of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Kurukshetra, whereby order dated 26.08.2013 of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kurukshetra discharging the petitioner was set aside, order framing charges dated 18.11.2015 and chargesheet dated 23.11.2015 alongwith all subsequent proceedings, have been sought.

During the pendency of the present petitions, since civil suit between the parties has already been decided, parties have moved miscellaneous application bearing CRM-27112-2019 for placing on record application dated 24.03.2014 filed by respondent No.2 and statements of Amar Singh son of Amolak Ram and joint statement of Balbir Singh and Jaswant Singh son of Kundan Singh, as also order dated 03.07.2017 passed by the Presiding Officer, Daily Lok Adalat-cum-Civil Judge (Junior Division), Kurukshetra.

Application bearing CRM-27112-2019 is allowed.

According to the aforesaid statements, parties had settled their dispute by mutual settlement and they had undertaken to get the criminal prosecution quashed.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.2 does not dispute the correctness of the statements recorded before the Presiding Officer, Daily Lok Adalat-cum-Civil Judge (Junior Division), Kurukshetra.

In view of the aforesaid settlement having been arrived at, FIR No.70 dated 24.07.2006 registered under Sections 420, 463, 467, 471, 120-B, 506 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Jhansa, District Kurukshetra, and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, shall stand quashed.

In view of the above, both the petitions are disposed of.
