Grievance of the petitioner is that though he was appointed as Driver way back in the year 1998 and has rendered uninterrupted service of more than 19 years ever since, yet he is being paid salary on daily wages at D.C rates and has not been accorded the benefit of regularization in accordance with Regularization of Ad hoc, Contractual, Daily Wager, Temporary, Work Charged and Outsourced Employee's Welfare Act, 2016. In the premise, the petitioner also submitted representation dated 08.02.2019 (Annexure P-4), which has not been adverted to by the respondents till date. Hence the petition.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On advance service of copy of the petition, Ms. Anu Chatrath, Senior Advocate assisted by Ms. Ambika Bedi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, appears on behalf of respondents.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the representation (Annexure P-4) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in this petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

6. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

7. Disposed of in above terms.
