ANIL KSHETARPAL, J.

Learned counsel for the State, on the instructions from SI Subhash Chander, has informed the Court that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and report of the Forensic Science Laboratory is awaited. He has further submitted that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

Learned counsel for the complainant has submitted that the petitioner had committed offences under the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

Prima facie, the contention does not appear to be correct, however, it would not be appropriate for this Court to express any final opinion on the merits of the case.

In the present case, a registered sale-deed was executed which is alleged to be without payment of the consideration and result of fraud by the complainant.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the interim order dated 15.11.2018 passed by this Court is made absolute.

The present petition stands disposed of.
