Report dated 11.06.2019 of the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Batala has been received whereby after recording statements of respondent No.2-Jyoti and accused/petitioner, namely, Sukhdev Masih @ Sukhdev Singh, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of their own free will, without any undue

influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the offence for which the accused has been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.20 dated 22.04.2015 registered at Police Station Sri Hargobindpur, Batala District Batala, under Sections 354 and 452 of the IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR *qua* the petitioner are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
