Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.549 dated 30.10.2018, under Sections 419 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Sadar Thanesar, District Kurukshetra.

While issuing notice of motion, this court passed the following order on 16.11.2018 :-

“On instructions from ASI Raj Kumar, learned State counsel seeks some time to have instructions as to what is the role of the petitioner?”

Adjourned to 23.01.2019.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to join investigation before the Investigating officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction, subject to the conditions mentioned below, as envisaged in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C:

- i. that the petitioner shall make themselves available for interrogation by Police Officer as and when required;*
- ii. that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him*

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from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;

iii. that the petitioner shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.”

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Raj Kumar has acknowledged that in terms of the previous order the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required in this case.

In view of above, the interim order dated 16.11.2018 is made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.
