Vide order dated 27.05.2019, the case was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and report of the Mediator dated 31.05.2019 received to the effect that the parties have settled their dispute amicably.

Mr. Baljinder Virk, DAG, Haryana, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Baljeet Kaur submits that the petitioner is not required for investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim protection granted vide order dated 15.11.2018 is made absolute.

In the light of the statement made by the learned State

counsel and the report received from the Mediator, the interim protection granted to the petitioner vide order dated 15.11.2018 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
