This is a petition for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.68 dated 22.10.2018 registered under Section 304 IPC at Police Station Behram, District SBS Nagar.

On 15.11.2018 the following order was passed:-

“CRM-39965-2018

Allowed as prayed for subject to all just exceptions.

CRM-M-49992-2018

Notice of motion for 7.2.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the police and join investigation within a week. In the event of his arrest being required, he shall be released on interim bail till the next date, subject to his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, he shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) (i) to (iv) Cr.P.C. failing which he shall lose the benefit of interim bail allowed to him.”

Learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab on instructions from Investigating Officer ASI Nand Lal accepts the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. The interim order dated 15.11.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
