Petitioner Bholli @ Bholla has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0086 dated 13.10.2018, registered at Police Station Lakho Ke Behram, District Ferozepur, under Sections 384/506/120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 66-F of the IT Act.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

As per the prosecution version, Reena @ Renu borrowed a mobile phone of ₹6500/- from the complainant. Later on, the complainant used to talk with her on the mobile phone and once she asked him to take the money. The complainant along with his friends went to the house of Santo where he alleged that one Sukhwinder Singh @ Soni after forcibly

removing his clothes started making his video on the mobile phone. The present petitioner is stated to be present in the house of Santo at that time.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 15.11.2018, passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. She is not required for custodial interrogation. Nothing is to be recovered from her. No useful purpose would be served by sending the petitioner to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 15.11.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
