This is a criminal writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for the issuance of a writ in the nature of *habeas corpus* for the release of detenu-Sunita Devi, from the alleged illegal detention of respondents No.4 to 8.

Today, affidavit of respondent No.5 has been filed in the Court today.

As per the learned State counsel, the complaint of respondent No.5 has not been accepted by the police as FIR has already stood registered in this case.

As per the status report filed by way of affidavit of Surjit Singh, DSP, Payal, Sub Division Payal, it has been enquired into as to

whether detenu-Sunita Devi had been illegally confined or not, but she is not traceable in the house of father of respondent No.4 and even their mobile phones have been found to be switched off. As per the affidavit, detenu -Sunita and respondent No.4-Jaspal Ram @ Pala are not traceable from the day one.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present criminal writ petition with liberty to file fresh one as and when any cause of action arises.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
