The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 28.2.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No. 5374 of 2019. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and keeping in view the above facts, this petition is being disposed of by giving a direction to respondent No. 1 to consider the case of the petitioner for promotion, keeping in view instructions dated 11.9.2016, in accordance with law.”

Learned counsel for the respondent has produced order dated 7.8.2019 in court today. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

As per the order, the petitioner has been promoted as Deputy Director and is posted in Social Justice and Empowerment Department, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the order passed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, he seeks liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law if any grievance still survives.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
