Present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.252 dated 20.10.2018, under Sections 307, 353, 186, 332, 295, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Gate Hakima, District Amritsar.

On the previous date of hearing i.e. 01.12.2018, this Court passed the following order:-

“ CRM No.41905 of 2018

Present application has been filed for placing on record the MLR of Gurjinder Singh as Annexure P-4 with the further prayer seeking exemption from filing the certified as well as typed copy of the same.

For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed subject to all just exceptions. Accompanied documents are taken on record.

Registry to tag the same at the appropriate place.

MAIN CASE

*Short report by way of affidavit dated 30.11.2018 of
Sh. Narinder Singh, PPS, ACP, Central, Amritsar City on behalf*

of the respondent has been filed. The same is taken on record. Copy supplied to the opposite side.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners contends that the injured has suffered 07 injuries and all were simple in nature as is clear from the MLR dated 22.10.2018 (P-4).

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from S.I. Jagtar Singh, has stated that as a matter of fact, at the first instance, the injured was admitted in Hartej Maternity & Nursing Home, Amritsar on 20.10.2018 itself and he wishes to place on record the MLR of the injured, issued by Hartej Maternity & Nursing Home, Amritsar.

*Adjourned to **14.01.2019** for further consideration.*

In the meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of their arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit them to interim bail till the next date of hearing on their furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioners are also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Today, learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Vijay Kumar, submits that both the petitioners have joined the investigation in terms of order dated 01.12.2018 and their custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of above, interim order dated 01.12.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.
