Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.322 dated 16.05.2018 (**P-1**), under Section 174-A of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Mujessar, NIT, Faridabad.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 15.11.2018, passed the following order:-

“ It is contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the matter has been compromised between the parties and the complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act has already been dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 02.11.2018 (P-3).

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Today, A.S.I. Birpal, Police Station Mujessar, NIT, Faridabad submits that petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of order dated 15.11.2018 and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of above, interim order dated 15.11.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

The observations may not be considered as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
