This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.904 dated 14.11.2015 registered under Sections 420/468/216/120-B IPC and 66 of IT Act, 2000 and 7/8/13/49/88 of P.C. Act, 1988 registered at Police Station City Jind, District Jind.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the bail bonds of the petitioner were cancelled because he inadvertently could not appear on one date but he has never misused the concession of bail in the past and in this view of the matter the observations of the trial Court are a little uncharitable. He further states that the petitioner undertakes that he would appear on every date in future.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Gaurav Bansal, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and copy of the paper book

In my opinion, in case the averment that the petitioner has never previously misused the concession of bail, is correct then this one lapse can be condoned. In the circumstances, the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court on the date fixed (which is stated to be 22.05.2019) and in case the statement that he has never misused the concession of bail previously, is correct the Court would release him on bail to its satisfaction, subject to his furnishing an undertaking to the effect that he will appear regularly before the Court and will not seek exemption in future as the present case is the one of the oldest case.

In this view of the matter, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the prayer of the petitioner.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
