refiling the appeal, is condoned.

Application stands allowed.

The appellant has laid challenge to order dated 18.04.2019
rendered by the Single Judge of this Court in CWP-10314-2019.

The appellant was required to send hard copies of his online
application form along with self-attested copies of the certificate to the office
within a period of 15 days i.e. 25.03.2019. Case of the appellant is that
representations of certain similarly situated persons were accepted and they
were called for interview.

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that mother of the
appellant was suffering from sugar, thyroid and kidney disease and was
undergoing treatment in hospital and therefore he was unable to submit the

required documents.

Having heard learned counsel for the appellant and after going through the case file, we find that the appellant was not only the sole member in the family so as to accompany and look after his mother. Moreover, no plausible explanation has been tendered to enable this Court to differ with the finding recorded by the learned Single Judge.

The appellant, in our view, should have submitted the application form along with necessary documents on or before the prescribed date. There being no such strong and convincing reason given by the appellant for being remiss, this Court finds this appeal to be devoid of merit.

Dismissed.
