Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 138 dated 03.09.2018, under Sections 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Passiana, District Patiala.

On 15.11.2018, while issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that co-accused of the petitioner namely Mehnga Singh has filed CRM-M No.49848 of 2018, wherein notice of motion has been issued for 14.01.2019 and interim protection has also been granted.

Notice of motion for 14.01.2019.

To be heard along with CRM-M No.49848 of 2018.

Interim order in the same terms as passed in CRM-M No.49848 of 2018.”

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in terms of the order dated 15.11.2018, petitioner has joined the investigation.

On instructions from ASI Surinder Singh, the above

factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State counsel and stated that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no longer required in the present case.

In view of the above, the order dated 15.11.2018 is made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.

Petition stands disposed off.
