Petitioner is stated to be a Cooperative Labour and Construction Society.

Counsel submits that in years 2016, the work of Setting up Centres for Supplying Medicine to all patients to Government Hospitals was allotted to the petitioner by the Punjab Health System Corporation, State Institute of Health & Family Welfare.

Short grievance raised in the instant petition is that inspite of the work in question having been executed and completed, a payment of Rs.9,05,000/- approximately has not been released.

Counsel argues that the action of the respondent/authorities is unjust and unfair as the amount in question has been withheld without any justifiable basis.

Further submission is made that a legal notice dated 20.04.2019 (Annexure P-2) has already been submitted before the competent authority and he would be satisfied if the instant writ petition was to be disposed of with a direction to take a final decision thereupon within a stipulated time frame.

Submission made by counsel is found to be just and reasonable.

In view of the above and without ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition and without even going into the merits of the claim raised by the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition with a direction to respondent No.4 i.e. the Executive Engineer (C), Punjab Health Systems Corporation, Civil Hospital, Bathinda and to examine the claim of the petitioner against the backdrop of a legal notice dated 20.04.2019 (Annexure P-2) and to take a final decision thereupon expeditiously and in any case within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this Court.

Needless to observe that in case any outstanding amounts/funds are found due, the necessary funds would be released to the petitioner without any further delay.
