AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 11.01.2019 passed by this Court in CRM-M No.650 of 2019.

The relevant portion of the order is reproduced below:-

“The instant petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna, District Khanna to look into the said representation (Annexure P-3) and decide the same expeditiously preferably within 90 days, as per law, after the receipt of certified copy of this order.”

Reply was filed by the respondent annexing report dated 18.10.2018. In the report, it was concluded that no case is made out for police action, as there was no proof produced that husband of the

petitioner had re-married.

In view of reply filed, learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner be granted liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law against the report.

Disposed of as infructuous, with liberty as prayed for.
