The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0040 dated 14.04.2019 registered under Sections 406, 420 IPC at Police Station Balongi, District S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali.

The operative part of the order dated 21.05.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the year 2005, the plot in dispute was allotted by TDI in favour of Smt. Chanderlekha, who later on, sold the same to Nasib Kaur and thereafter, Nasib Kaur further sold the plot to Jatinder Sharma and from him the petitioner purchased the plot in the year 2008 by paying an amount of Rs.3 lacs to the vendor. Thereafter, the complainant deposited the installments with TDI and the dispute arose with regard to payment of Rs.1,62,500/- which the petitioner could not pay and the TDI had canceled the allotment which later on the petitioner has settled. It is further argued that the present FIR has been registered after a much delay in

the year 2019 and there is no fault on the part of the petitioner as the dispute arising of a purchase of the plot in which the petitioner has already cleared the payment.

Notice of motion for 29.05.2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 21.05.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Bhupender Kumar, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 21.05.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
