After arguing the matter for some time, finding that the Court is not inclined to grant the relief of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

However, it is submitted by counsel for the petitioner that since the petitioner is in custody for the last 02 years and 06 months, a direction be issued to the trial Court to conclude the trial.

Accordingly, this petition is *dismissed as withdrawn* with a direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously preferably within a period of 06 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
