The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of directions to the respondents No.2 and 3 so as to protect her life and liberty as she apprehends threat to the same at the hands of the private respondents.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner and private respondents are cousins and that while the petitioner is presently residing in North Delhi, she is not being permitted by the private respondents to visit her paternal home situated in Barnala as the private respondents intend to usurp the property of the petitioner, who happens to be the only daughter of her parents, and has no other brother or sister, and had inherited the property of her father.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Barnala to

look into the matter and to dispose of the representation dated 26.4.2019 (Annexure P-3), moved by petitioner, in accordance with law, at the earliest.

A copy of this order alongwith representation dated 26.4.2019 (Annexure P-3) be sent to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Barnala, so as to enable him to do the needful at the earliest.
