In the present petition a prayer has been made that mandamus be issued directing the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for change of place of residence.

The petitioner refers to the Form which was to be filled up online and State of Rajasthan immediately succeeds the State of Punjab in sequence. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner while filling up the Form filled up the State of Rajasthan as the place of residence instead of State of Punjab. It is stated that it was sheer inadvertence that led to the mistake and otherwise all other supporting documents indicate the correct position of the petitioner belonging to the State of Punjab. A representation has been made by the petitioner in this regard which has gone unanswered so far.

We would, therefore, without commenting on the merits of the case but looking at the grievance raised before us, deem it appropriate to dispose of the petition with a direction to the competent authority to take a decision on the claim of the petitioner within a period of three days from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Ordered accordingly.

We would expect a sympathetic consideration considering that such an error is not in the realm of improbability.

The petitioner is at liberty to move a fresh representation along with a copy of the order in order to supplement the earlier one.

Disposed of.
