The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case Cross Case registered under Sections 307, 326, 324, 341, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code in FIR No.109 dated 08.08.2018 under Sections 354-A, 324, 323, 506, 427 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sudhar, District Ludhiana.

It has been submitted that the only injury attributed to the petitioner is that he gave a kirpan (sword) blow hitting on the left side of the head of the injured, was found to be grievous.

The petitioner is in custody since 10.02.2019. The trial of the case

will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Aman @ Kachu is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to payment of Rs.50,000/- by way of bank draft to the victim, as interim compensation. The said bank draft shall be submitted before the trial Court and the trial Court shall hand over the same to the complainant. The aforesaid amount will be without prejudice to the rights of the parties and shall be subject to the final outcome of the trial. Petitioner Aman @ Kachu shall also furnish bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate and shall remain bound by the following conditions:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court.
