HARI PAL VERMA, J.(Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that during the pendency of the petition, matter has been resolved between the parties and petitioner No.1-Rajesh Kumar as well as respondent No.2-Barkha are staying together as husband and wife. He seeks permission to withdraw the present petition, however, with liberty to file fresh one for quashing of FIR No.13 dated 07.01.2016 registered under Sections 498-A, 406, 506, 34 of IPC at Police Station Sector 7, Faridabad, on the basis of compromise.

Considering the statement made by counsel for the petitioners, he is permitted to withdraw the present petition, however, with liberty to file fresh one for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise if so arrived at between the parties.

In case the matter has not been compromised between the parties, the petitioners would be at liberty to revive the present petition.

It is made clear that in case petitioner No.1 and respondent No.2 are living together as husband and wife, they shall not be arrested for a period of two months from today and during this period, the petitioners would be at liberty to file a petition seeking quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.
