Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.178 dated 11.06.2017 registered under Sections 307, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act, 1860 at Police Station Nangal Choudhary, District Mahendergarh.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that petitioner was arrested on 19.03.2019 whereas the case of other co-accused namely Dharampal, Jageshwar and Manjeet, separate trial has resulted in their acquittal. He has further drawn attention of the Court to the statement of complainant as noticed by the Court in para 6 of the judgment dated 26.02.2018 wherein it has been noticed that the complainant was declared hostile.

Investigation against the petitioner is complete and challan has been presented.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
