Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.62 dated 07.06.2015 registered under Sections 341, 323, 148, 149, 506, 120-B, 325 of the Indian Penal Code at police station Satnampura, District Kapurthala.

On 29.05.2019, while issuing notice of motion in the main case, the following order was passed by this Court:

“Contentends that petitioners are regularly appearing before learned trial Court and now Section 325, IPC has been added. Further contends that petitioners are ready to join the investigation.

Notice of motion for 16.08.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to surrender before learned trial Court. On their doing so, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail in the present case till the next date of hearing subject to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate

concerned.”

On instructions from ASI Bhinder Pal, learned State counsel has apprised the Court that in terms of the order dated 29.05.2019, the petitioners have joined the proceedings before learned trial Court on 08.08.2019 and furnished their requisite bail/surety bonds.

In view of the above, the order dated 29.05.2019 is made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.

Petition stands disposed off.

However, it is clarified that the petitioners shall fully co-operate with proceedings before learned trial Court and shall not commit any recurrence in future.
