Instant writ petition has been filed seeking a mandamus for directing the official respondents to take necessary steps for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner as also his family members by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents.

Pleadings on record would indicate that the petitioner is owner in possession of land measuring 37 kanals and 7 marlas. There are allegations that the private respondents at the instance of a political heavy weight is making an attempt to grab the property of the petitioner.

It has been conceded that till date the petitioner has not resorted to his civil remedy of seeking an injunction against the private respondents even, if the assertions taken in the instant writ petition are true.

Even the threat perception voiced in the instant writ petition as per the averments made does not inspire confidence.

Confronted with such a situation, where this Court was not inclined to intervene, counsel prays for withdrawal of the writ petition.

Writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
