Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.34 dated 27.04.2018 under Sections 420, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station City-2 Mansa, District Mansa.

While granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, following order was passed on 16.11.2018: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that two co-accused of the petitioner namely Buta Singh and Shakuntla Rani have already been granted the concession of anticipatory bail in CRM-M-36973-2018 and CRM-M-48509-2018 respectively. It is further submitted that as per allegations in the FIR, the petitioner, along with other accused persons, has cheated grandson of the complainant with a promise that they will solemnize his marriage with another co-accused Manpreet Kaur. It is further stated in the FIR that the complainant had paid certain amount to the petitioner and co-accused Gurnam Kaur, who acted as a mediator and a fake

marriage was performed with Manpreet Kaur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that though there are allegations in the FIR that the petitioner is involved in such activities, but she is not involved in another FIR and is first offender. It is further submitted that in fact the grandson of complainant and said Manpreet Kaur could not pull on their marriage and on that account, the petitioner is involved in the present FIR.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajpal, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 16.11.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
