Grievance of the petitioner is that he has rendered uninterrupted service as 'Sweeper' for the past more than 28 years as he was originally appointed in the year 1991 and yet he has not been accorded the benefit of regularization in accordance with the applicable policy of the State.

2. The petitioner has caused a legal notice dated 15.01.2019 (Annexure P-4) but the same has not been adverted to by the respondents till date. Hence the present writ petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On an advance service of copy of the petition, Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG, Punjab, appears on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

6. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents, as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required in the present case.

7. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the legal notice dated 15.01.2019 (Annexure P-4) and also by keeping in view the averments and contentions stated in this petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

8. Let needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
