The petitioners filed a writ petition seeking directions to the respondents to grant the benefit of ad-hoc service towards seniority with all consequential benefits along-with interest. The petition was disposed of on 02.11.2018 with the directions to the respondents to consider the representation Annexure P-5 (in the writ petition) in view of the judgment rendered in CWP No. 8604 of 2007 titled as **Dr. Surinder Kumar Mishra and others vs. State of Haryana and others.** The needful was to be done within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

The present petition is filed pleading wilful disobedience of the directions of this Court.

Learned State counsel fairly submits that though the representation was considered and order dated 06.12.2019 was passed but while passing the order the afore-said judgment has not been taken into consideration. He, on

instructions from Ms. Rajesh Kumari, Deputy Superintendent, O/o Director General of Higher Education, Haryana submits that a fresh decision on the representation in compliance with the directions of this Court after considering the afore-said judgment would be taken within four weeks from today.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of.

Petitioners would be at liberty to revive the present petition in case the afore-said statement made today is not adhered to. However, petitioners shall be at liberty to avail remedy in case aggrieved of order passed.
