Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.229 dated 13.08.2018 under Sections 406, 498-A, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Power of attorney filed on behalf of complainant-respondent No.2 today in the Court, is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 16.11.2018 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kewal Singh,

does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation

of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 16.11.2018 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
