Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.191 dated 14.08.2018 under Sections 498-A, 420, 506, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Khanna.

Power of attorney filed on behalf of complainant-respondent No.2 today in the Court, is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 16.11.2018 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Harmit, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of

the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

At this stage, learned counsel for the complainant-respondent No.2 states that there are specific allegations against the petitioner.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and her custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 16.11.2018 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
