Petitioner challenges the order dated 26.04.2019 (Annexure P-1) whereby his services were terminated by the Senior Executive Engineer (Distribution) CMC (Spl.) Ludhiana, from 01.04.2013. On 20.05.2019, the following order was passed:

“Counsel seeks time to complete instructions as to whether the petitioner would have a statutory remedy of appeal under the Punjab State Electricity Board (Now the PSPCL) Punishment and Appeal Regulations, 1971 against the order of termination dated 26.04.2019 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Senior Executive Engineer, Distribution, CMC Division (Spl.), PSPCL, Ludhiana.

List on 06.08.2019.”

Counsel submits that an appeal has been preferred on 06.06.2019 before the Appellate Authority. He, accordingly, prays that the present writ petition has become infructuous and the same may be disposed of, as such, with liberty to press the appeal before the Appellate Authority.
