ANIL KSHETARPAL, J. (ORAL) :

Petitioner No.1 is father-in-law whereas petitioner No.2 is the unmarried sister-in-law of the daughter of respondent No.4.

It is alleged that a complaint has been received by the Non-Resident Indian Wing of Punjab Police from Harmeen Kaur, who at present resides in Canada. Learned counsel for the petitioners has pointed out that earlier also a similar complaint was lodged by respondent No.4-father of Harmeen Kaur, which, after investigation was filed on the basis of a compromise. In the present petition, petitioners pray for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to provide adequate protection to their life and liberty.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and particularly noticing that the marriage between Harmeen Kaur and Gurbinder Singh-son of petitioner No.1, took place in Canada, the present petition is disposed of, directing that if the petitioners are required to be arrested they shall be given a 7 days' notice in advance.

The petition stands disposed of.
