The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr. P. C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.156 dated 06.10.2018 registered under Sections 420, 406 and 120-B IPC at Police Station City Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur.

Pursuant to the previous order dated 26.07.2019 passed by this court, affidavit has been filed by investigating officer of the case, which is taken on record. In the affidavit steps, which were taken to arrest the accused before the matter reached the Supreme Court, have been mentioned. It has also been stated in the affidavit that the accused has since been arrested and is now in judicial custody.

In view of the above, this court does not find any reason to pass any adverse order against the investigating officer of the case.

Since the accused is reported to have been arrested and sent to the judicial custody, therefore, the present petition has been rendered as infructuous.
