The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.53 dated 8.6.2016 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 324, 452, 427, 354-A, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Kathu Nangal, District Amritsar Rural, Amritsar.

Heard.

It has been submitted that the petitioners were earlier declared innocent during the investigation but later on they were summoned under Section 319 of the Cr.P.C. to face trial as additional accused.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioners are no more required for custodial interrogation.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 16.11.2018 is made absolute till the

presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioners shall make themselves available for interrogation as and when required by the police;
- (ii) that the petitioners shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against them so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioners shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioners will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
