In the present writ petition, the claim of the petitioner is for the release of General Provident Fund amount after he retired on 31.07.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that there is no impediment in the release of the said benefits but still, the petitioner has not been given the amount of GPF for which he is entitled.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has submitted the respondents with a representation dated 07.02.2019 (Annexure P-2) and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 07.02.2019 (Annexure P-2), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 07.02.2019 (Annexure P-2) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits after the decision of the representation, the same should also be paid to him within three months thereafter.
