ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 287, dated 04.12.2018, under Sections 395 and 411 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short), registered at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR wherein it is mentioned that 15-20 persons had taken away 480 bags of wheat from a godown after breaking open the locks. He also contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case. The petitioner is 65 years of age and is in custody for over 05 months. He has also been falsely implicated in 2 other FIRs wherein he has not been named.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Kulwant Singh states that 118 bags of wheat were recovered from the petitioner. He also states that the challan has been presented but charges are yet to be framed.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is 65 years of age, he is in custody for over 5 months, he was not named in the FIR and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
